
### **Client Information**

#### **Problem Statement**

  - 1. Having limited quizzes available and the content of the quizzes not matching the course content
  - 2. Not all quizzes are free on the New York Times
  - 3. The students have to submit a screenshot of their results on the New York Times website




### **Solution Overview**

- We need a custom Web Application RedPen
- This application will replace the use of the NYT version
- Login/privileges for two groups
  - Administrator (only Dr. Konrad)
    - Make custom quizzes for students
    - See the results of students' quizzes (completed or not)
  - Student
    - Take provided quizzes for practice
    - Allow alumni with continuous access to all available quizzes



### Implementation Overview

- Key requirements
  - Privileges, student/admin pages
  - Store student/quiz data
  - Free and easy to use
- Use of a multitier (3-tier in our case) architecture
- Use NAU ITS hosting for website and database





### Implementation Details

- Front End Modules
  - User Authentication: Handles user and admin login
  - Quiz Interface: Allows for easy creation of quizzes and display them
  - Stats board: Allows users to view quiz results in a easy way.
- Back End Modules
  - Authentication Management: Manages authentication using NAU server
  - Quiz Management: Allows for questions, answers and scores to be accounted for
  - Data Access: Allows all user/quiz data to be stored in the database.




## Challenges and Resolutions

- Technological Challenges
  - NAU ITS Outage affected our Database
  - Created a temporary external phpMyAdmin/MySQL server
- Integration Challenges
  - Merging front-end with back-end components
    - HTML with PHP
    - PHP with Javascript
  - A systematic approach to reviewing PHP files
- Risks
  - Database crashing




