

Human Powered Vehicle



- 1. Lower body onto the seat
- 2. Place both feet on pedals located at the front of the bike
- 3. Fasten seatbelt by pulling down from the top-right side and buckle it across body to lower left hip.
- 4. Handles for steering are located at the side of the rider
- 5. To turn left, the left steering arm is pushed down and to turn right, the right arm is pushed down
- 6. Brakes are located on the steering handles, and to brake, squeeze them
- 7. Gears are located on the right steering arm, and to shift gears, rotate left or right for lower or higher gears respectively
- 8. To pedal, force feet to push pedals to rotate and propel the bike
- 9. Trunk space is located behind the head
- 10. Always wear a helmet when riding
